Regular Council Meeting of September 9, 2020

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Reserve Bid for Tax Sale

The reserve bids were set for the tax sale of the following parcels, with the terms for the sale to be cash, certified cheque or bank draft to be received within 48 hours of sale:

- Roll # 1016550 at 6044AJ;6;6 to be set at \$31,170
- Roll # 1016600 at 6044AJ;6;7 to be set at \$2,300

Bylaw 10-20 Amendment to Land Use Bylaw

Council approved first reading of Bylaw 10/20, for the purpose of amending Land Use Bylaw 09/18 to redistrict Pt.SE-30-45-15 W4, Plan 0321422, Block 1, Lot 1 (3.93 acres) which is the "Agricultural (A) District" to "Rural Industrial (RI) District", for the purpose of accommodating an "Oilfield Support" business.

Bylaw 11-20 Amendment to FRSDAB Bylaw and Agreement

The Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Agreement was approved with the addition of Village of Amisk, as presented.

Council approved Bylaw 11-20, an amendment to Bylaw 04/19 the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board bylaw, which adds the Village of Amisk as a member.

Unsightly, Non-Conforming or Dangerous Properties

Council approved the following:

1. Administration develop an Unsightly Bylaw to assist in the enforcement of unsightly properties.
2. Unsightly properties are managed on a complaint basis for rural properties and by complaint and/or inspection for urban properties.
3. Administration proceed with a Land Use Bylaw amendment to allow for the use of Violation Tags to enforce non-conforming properties.

Friends of the Battle River Railway—Request

A donation in the amount of \$3,000 will not be provided to the Friends of the Battle River Railway to go towards the air conditioner for the passenger car.

Municipal Stimulus Program Grant

The Municipal Stimulus Grant Funding Program projects list was deferred to the next Council meeting of September 23, 2020 for further information, and to communicate with all Flagstaff municipalities to determine other potential shovel ready projects that meet the objectives of the grant.
