Municipal Stimulus Program Grant

The Municipal Stimulus Grant Funding will be utilized on capital Bridge Projects (Bridge Files 13353, 6665, 2421, 1218) with an estimated project cost of \$471,000.

Pine Cliff Energy Ltd—Request for Payments on Taxes

Council approved to allow Pine Cliff Energy Ltd. to pay the 2020 outstanding taxes by way of twelve (12) equal monthly payments and waive the penalties.

Town of Hardisty Aerodrome

Flagstaff County will not enter into an agreement with the Town of Hardisty to share revenue from taxable assessment at the Hardisty aerodrome/ airport.

Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society—Responses

Reeve Kroetch, Clr. Skoberg and CAO Armstrong meet with each municipality to discuss fire services and clarify their position regarding the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS).

Policy Review

Camrose Association for Community Living—2020 Virtual Charity Auction

Due to an anticipated reduction in revenues, no donation will be provided to Camrose Association for Community Living to support their 2020 Virtual Charity Auction.

Parkland Regional Library

Due to an anticipated reduction in revenues, the proposed 2021 Parkland Regional Library budget not be approved at a requisition of \$8.55 per capita.

Diplomat Mine Museum—Request for Gravel and grading of parking lot

A grader will be supplied to grade the parking lot area at the Diplomat Mine Museum site, but additional gravel will not be supplied due to an anticipated reduction in revenues.

Delegation—Request for Refund on Residential Dust Suppressant

A refund was not granted to the landowner for the residential dust suppressant, and that administration will investigate a product suitable for residential dust suppressant; and to develop a policy to address the possibility of private companies providing approved residential dust suppressant.
