Regular Council Meeting of June 22, 2022

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Town of Whitecourt – FCM Resolution

Council approved to support the Town of Whitecourt's request and endorse their Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Resolution: Federal support for Canadian consumption of Canadian oil and gas resources. They are requesting FCM call on the Government of Canada to:

- promote and encourage the consumption of Canadian oil and gas products over the use of energy products imported from other countries; and
- implement policy that requires all imported oil and gas consumed in Canada to meet the same laws that Canadian producers must adhere to, including governance, environmental and human rights standards.

Ducks Unlimited Canada Conservation Lease for Wetland Restoration and Retention

Council approved to enter into a Conservation Lease with Ducks Unlimited Canada for Wetland Restoration and Retention Small Flood Area on the undeveloped road allowance between NE 7-46-14-W4 and SE 18-46-14-W4.

Flagstaff Victim Services

Council approved that funding the Flagstaff Victim Services Society in the amount of \$10,500 per year be considered during the 2023-2025 Business Plan and Budget process.

Council approved the request from Flagstaff Victim Services that the remaining grant funds from 2020 and 2021 in the amount of \$6,988.35 be utilized for training for the Volunteer Victim Services Unit advocates.
