Council Highlights



Regular Council Meeting of April 13, 2022

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Valley Ski Club – Support Application for FCC Agrispirit Fund

Council approved to partner with the Valley Ski Hill to support their grant application for the Farm Credit Canada AgriSpirit fund for the purpose of renovations or upgrades that reduce a building's energy footprint.

Agriculture Policy Review

Council approved the following policies as presented:

- AG 002 Weed and Pest Control – no revisions;
- AG 003 Weed and Pest Appeal Committee – as revised.

Council appointed Henry Hays, James Brodie, Roger Chevraux and Bill Dietrich to the Weed Appeal Committee for the 2022 term.

Shock Trauma Air Rescue Society (STARS)

Council approved that the annual funding for the Shock Trauma Air Rescue Society (STARS) be increased to \$8,000 for 2022, 2023 and 2024.

Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS)

Council approved the following:

- That Flagstaff County accepts the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS) Draft Budget for 2022, 2023 and 2024 as presented.
- That Flagstaff County accepts that the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS) total 2022 municipal requisitions be increased to \$1,068,500 from \$1,000,000, therefore increasing the cap of total operating budget by \$68,500 and that the \$68,500 increase is put into operating reserves.
- That Flagstaff County accepts the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS) 3-year capital budget as presented.

Farm Safety Centre

Council accepted the request from the Agricultural Service Board to financially support the efforts of the Farm Safety Centre in 2022 for program delivery to schools within Flagstaff County.

Employee Engagement Survey Results – Council

Council approved a new Organizational Structure, which addresses the senior leaders succession plan and additional changes to better align departments in the same divisions.

Avoid 6% Tax Penalty

A penalty of 6% (six per cent) will be levied on all unpaid taxes on May 2. To avoid penalties, payments made by mail must be postmarked no later than May 2, 2022, and payments made by Internet Banking or TelPay must be received no later than May 2, 2022.
